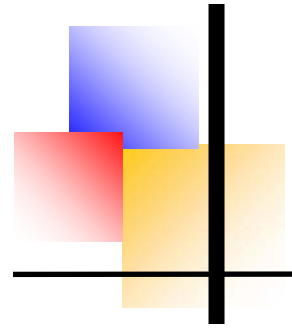
Thursday, June 17, 2010 9:30 am – 12:30 pm
