The Rev. Drew Phoenix on what it means to be transgender in the UMC



The Rev. Drew Phoenix has been a United Methodist elder for more than 20 years. He has served a variety of ethnically diverse, urban congregations in Maryland and Washington, DC, inspiring congregations to engage in community ministries informed by social justice. Rev. Phoenix is currently serving in Anchorage, Alaska.

Rev. Phoenix came out publicly as transgender to the clergy and laity of the Baltimore-Washington Conference in 2007. Despite several charges filed against him as a transgender minister, his position as an ordained elder was upheld and no anti-transgender legislation was added to **The Book of Discipline** at the 2008 General Conference.
