Report-back for the Monitoring Group sponsored by the Task Force

The Ecumenical Voice for Peace and Human Rights in the Philippines (EVPHRP) has been convened by the National Council of Churches of the Philippines to form a short-term international observation mission for the 2010 elections. The EVPHRP is made up of several Philippine religious and human rights groups. It has sent a world-wide request for election observers to be sent to the Philippines for the May 2010 Elections.

This observation mission sought to reduce election fraud by providing presence and by documenting the election. Election observers observed the election process and will report if the election was conducted according to national law and international standards.
